1. AVAILABILITY. To ensure a successful training program, you (the owner) must be ready, willing and able to do your part. This includes an introduction meeting on the Sunday drop-off date and a learning demonstration on the Friday depart date. Please schedule all services based on your availability.

2. BOARD & TRAIN AGREEMENT. For best results – as well as a safe and enjoyable stay at The Barkley, all pets must have a Board & Train Agreement completed prior to commencement of training sessions.

3. VACCINATIONS. All dogs must be in good health and must meet the following vaccination standards:

RABIES: Current in the last year for puppies and the past three years for adults.

DHLPP: Current in the last year.*

BORDETELLA: Current in the last **six months**.

FECAL EXAM: Current in last year

Pets requiring vaccination updates must have the vaccination(s) administered no less than ten days before any overnight stay or training is scheduled. Individual circumstances may be considered with written documentation from a veterinarian. Titers are accepted with proper documentation.

Puppies must be at least 9 weeks of age and have completed their first two series of vaccinations, including the Bordetella vaccine and a fecal exam. Puppies over 18 weeks of age must have their full series of vaccinations, including the rabies vaccine.

*Leptospirosis has become a major problem in Northeast Ohio and is not only contagious to other animals, but is also contracted by humans. There is a growing debate in the veterinary community as to if the vaccine is necessary. Because it puts our pet guests, staff, and human clients at a health risk, we have no choice but to require this vaccination.

You must be able to provide documentation from your veterinarian stating that vaccinations were given. This is for the protection of your dog and other dogs using the facilities.

4. FOOD/BELONGINGS. To help minimize digestive upset, which can become a training distraction, you are required to provide food for your dog for the entire length of the stay. Each meals serving size should be prepared in a separate baggie with your pet's name on it. The Barkley provides comfortable, clean bedding, toys and blankets which comfort your dog and adhere to a strict set of safety standards. Therefore, no belongings should be provided.

5. MEDICATIONS. Please bring all medications needed for your dog for the entire length of the stay.

6. DEPOSIT. A fifty (50%) percent deposit is due prior to the start of the Residency.

7. PAYMENT. We accept checks and cash only. Checks should be made out to Ashley's Canine Training Corp.
